

WHAT DO I NEED WHEN APPLYING FOR A LIBRARY CARD?

Library cards are free when you live within in the City Limits of Pierre or Fort Pierre. If you live in Hughes County, Stanley County or in another county, the rate for one family card is \$15.00 per year.

To obtain an adult library card, you will need:

- Your photo ID
- Piece of cancelled mail to provide proof of permanent address
- The name, address and phone number of friend or family to be used as back-up contact

To obtain a library card for a child, the parent/legal guardian will need:

The parent/legal guardian must authorize the application for their minor child.

The parent/legal guardian will be responsible for all items borrowed from or used in Rawlins Municipal Library by their minor child.

- Parent/Legal Guardian is required to have their own library card. This library card must be in good standing.
- Parent/Legal Guardian photo ID
- Piece of cancelled mail to provide proof of Parent/Legal Guardian permanent address
- The name, address and phone number of friend or family to be used as back-up contact
