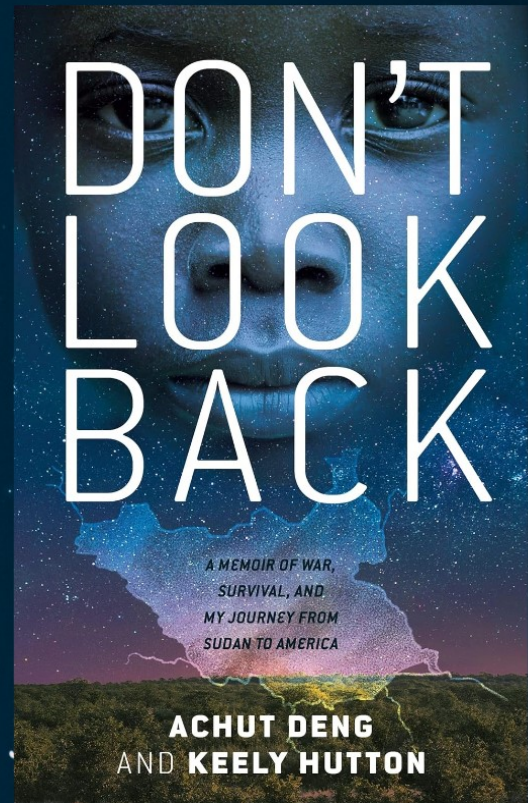

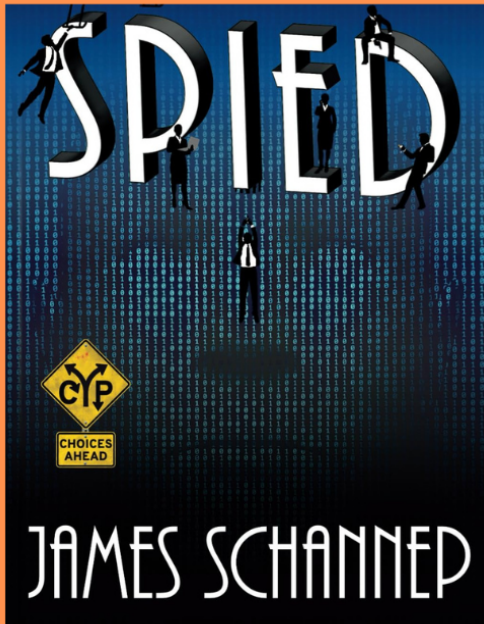

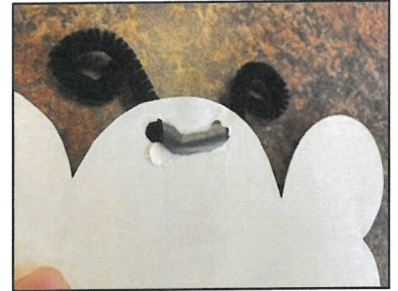


# Bumblebee Craft

You will need

- Scotch tape
- Elmer's glue
- Pencil with eraser

1.) Thread the pipe cleaner through the holes near the top of the bee's head, curl each end of the pipe cleaner, and tape it on the back as shown.



2.) With each wing's "clean" white side up, spread a thin layer of glue on the flap of each wing. Then, attach the wings to the back of the bee's body, and let dry.



3.) Gently fold a square of tissue paper or streamer around your pencil's eraser, press a small dot of glue on your bee where you want to put the square, and gently press your square onto the dot of glue as shown.

Do this with each square until you've filled your bee. You may press the **lighter-colored** squares to the **light** part of the pattern and the **dark** squares to the **black** part of the pattern, opposite, or something entirely different!

4.) Rub glue on the back of each googly eye, and position the eyes on your bee. You may need to gently push and hold each eye down on top of the "puffs" you made the eyes in place until they dry.

**\*Optional:** Glue the included black triangle onto the bee's stinger to make the stinger longer and stronger!

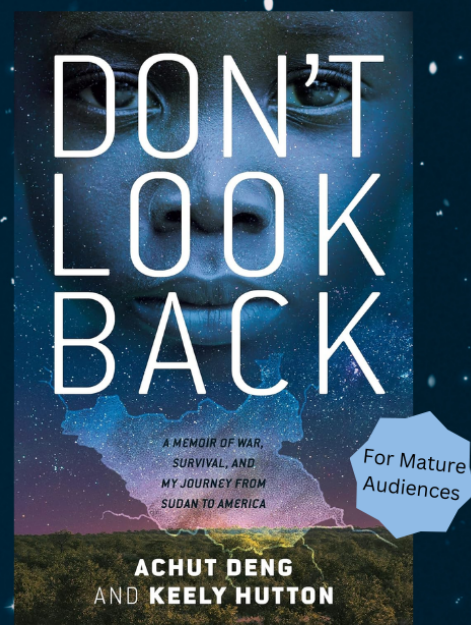
